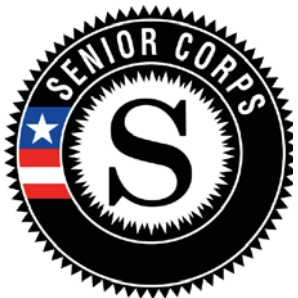

What is a Foster Grandparent Volunteer?

Foster Grandparent Volunteers are role models, mentors, and friends to children. The program provides an opportunity for volunteers age 55 and over to be active in their community by serving children and youth.



What Foster Grandparent Volunteers Do:

Foster Grandparents volunteer at non-profits, schools, Head Start programs, after-school programs, or day care centers to support youth in their educational or developmental needs.

Foster Grandparent Volunteers will:

- Work with children inside the classroom or on the playground
- Help with puzzles, games, and other educational activities
- Read with children
- Help children reach developmental milestones, like tying their own shoes
- Help with lunch and snacks
- Assist children through one-on-one mentoring and emotional support

They will NOT:

- Change diapers
- Be left alone with children
- Bring children into their home
- Discipline children

Benefits:

- An hourly, tax-free stipend
- Paid time off
- Partial travel reimbursement
- Annual recognition events
- Experiencing the joy of making a difference in the lives of local children who need help
